Entries must be on an official ASCA entry form. Entries are taken in POSTMARK ORDER; overnight express is not necessary. If you choose to use overnight, waive the signature required. Entry forms can be downloaded from www.asca.org. If your dog is not ASCA® registered, you must have a tracking number in order for your titles to be counted. However, a tracking number is not required to compete. All entries must be accompanied by payment. Please write legibly. Incomplete or illegible entries will not be accepted. Include checks payable to ASC of ID **Entries open July 20, 2026**, and **close August 3, 2026** Divisions will run for all classes of stock: Advanced, Open, Started, Novice, Junior, FEO. Entries will be accepted until the trial fills. Once the trial fills, additional entries will be put on a waiting list in postmark order. If space is available day of entries will be taken from 7:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. day of trial prior to start of said trial.

(All fees shall be paid at in US dollars) - (ASCA sanction pending)

FEES: Cattle: \$65.00 - Sheep: \$50.00 - Ducks: \$35.00

(Run all 3 stock in a trial \$140.00 per trial) or (all 4 arena trials for \$530)

After close of entries add \$5.00 additional for each run.

All courses to be run counter clockwise

- Sheep and cattle arena size: 150 x 250
- Duck arena size: 70 x 90
- Draw will be posted prior to the start of trial
- Bitches in season will run in draw order
- Move ups are allowed, but they may not be recorded correctly unless written notification is provided to the trial secretary prior to the start of the trial
- Entry fees will be refunded only when a dog has been certified by a licensed veterinarian as unable to compete due to illness or injury. Owner will be responsible for all vet fees.
- Refunds will be given if the trial fills and there is a replacement. Dogs may be substituted if owned by the same person
- Selling runs will not be permitted unless the trial is full.
- If the trial is full and you wish to sell a run, the transaction must be handled by the trial secretary. All offers to buy or sell runs must be submitted in writing at least one hour before the trial starts. No exceptions
- Note that the number designation on a trial does not indicate or restrict the order in which the trials will be held
- Run limits and judging assignments are subject to change
- Protective boots may be worn by the dogs.
- No dogs are allowed to run loose, except while competing
- Owner of dog will be responsible for any veterinary expense to the stock. Replacement cost will be \$30.00 ducks, \$300.00 sheep, market value for cattle – **Absolutely No excessive running of any stock will be allowed!**
- Individuals will be responsible for any damage done to equipment/fencing
- ASC of Idaho may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the ASC of Idaho, club members or any official thereof.

*Rules for HC weekend Awards:

- Each dog competing for a High Combined Weekend Award must be entered in all trials and all classes of stock on each day to be eligible. Exceptions will be for the High Combined in each stock (cattle, ducks, sheep) or for HC Junior award.
- A dog can only win one HC Weekend award of WTCH, Non-WTCH, HC Open, HC Other Breed, HC MPS Other Breed or MPS Aussie.
- All scores will be included in the total for high combined awards with the exception of the Junior award. Only Sheep and Ducks will count.

ASCA® rules apply. ASC of Idaho and their members assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by an exhibitor, handler, dog, property, child or spectator. No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies, weather, or other events beyond the control of ASC of ID. Entries must be made on the official and current ASCA® entry form.

High Combined Awards for Non WTCH, Open and MPS Can only be won once for each Trial (Idaho Classic) or (Gem State Spectacular). Example: If you win the HC Open Award at the Gem State Spectacular in 2025 you will not be eligible in 2026.

High Score Weekend Award - (single highest score for the weekend out of arena trials

Daily Awards

First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded. Green qualifying ribbons will be given to runs with qualifying scores

Junior Awards Ribbons 1st-4th

High Combined Junior Handler and High Combined Working Junior. Junior's Entry will be ½ the entry for the Junior Handler Classes. A Scholarship will be offered for working at the trial to pay the remaining fee.

Example: Junior Stockdog Handler prices Cattle-\$30, Sheep-\$22.50, Ducks-\$17.50 Juniors entered in Open Junior (titling classes) will pay regular fee
